How to Use Your CURVi Nail Cutter

Thanks for buying the CURVi! This is a special kind of nail cutter that works a bit differently from the ones you may have used before. But don't worry — it's super easy once you get the hang of it!

Step-by-Step Guide

1. Hold it the right way

Hook your middle finger around the bottom handle. Don't wrap your whole hand around it — this way gives you better control.

2. Place your nail on the bottom plate

Gently slide your nail onto the flat plate at the bottom. Make sure your nail is flat and sitting nicely on the plate. Keep device in line with lay of the nail.

3. Start cutting from one side

Press the handle down to make a cut. Then move along the nail and do the next cut. Keep working your way around!

4. No flying nail clippings!

CURVi helps keep nail pieces from shooting across the room. Just tap the device gently to let the bits fall out.

5. Go slow and feel your way

It's okay to take your time. You'll feel when the nail is ready to cut. No need to rush.

6. For toenails too!

Toenails can be thicker. Wiggle the plate under the nail just like with your fingers. Then press to cut — no need to worry about cutting too much.

Tips to Remember:

- You control how deep the cut goes CURVi won't let you cut too far.
- If it feels like it's not cutting, check if the handle is already pressed down. Let it go before placing your nail in again.
- With a little practice, you'll be a CURVi pro!
